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Case 1: P2026000959



- 57 y/o F, NKMI, nulliparous.
- c/o painless left thigh swelling since December 2025 rapidly increasing in size and swelling in the left inguinal region. LOA for 3/12 without LOW.
- O/E: Left thigh well demarcated swelling 10x10cm, no ulceration & non tender. Left inguinal LN 4x8cm. No other LN enlargement.
- Blood investigations: FBC/FBP/RP/LFT: Unremarkable; LDH:988; CRP 9/65
- Clinical DDx: Cutaneous TCL, BCC.
- Pathology: Gross- Ellipse of skin 4x4mm with underlying cutaneous 5x3x3mm. Submitted entirely in 1 block.

Case 2: P2025004476

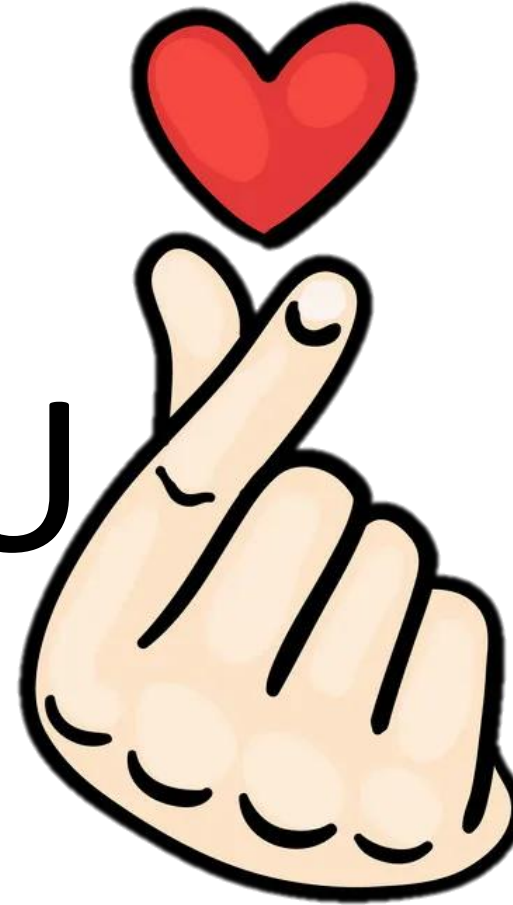
- 24 y/o F, NKMI, nulliparous.
- c/o Left breast swelling 3/12 associated with pain. Increasing in size, No discharge or skin changes.
- Left breast U/S: Irregular, non-circumscribed heterogenous hypoechoic lesion 2.9x4.2x3.5cm.
- Radiological Diagnosis: Phyllodes tumour/ malignancy.
- Pathology: Gross-3 strips of whitish tissue 20mm. Submitted entirely in two blocks.
